# PATIENT INSTRUCTIONS for COLLECTION

## Swube<sup>®</sup> Paddle

**CAUTION:** For accurate test results, read Patient Instructions completely before performing this test.

#### **Test Precautions:**

- → The Swube<sup>®</sup> Paddle is coated on one side with a tacky adhesive which collects and holds specimen.
- → Because of the migratory habits of the female pinworm, specimens are best obtained a few hours after the person has retired, between the hours of 9:00pm and midnight, or in the morning immediately upon rising before bathing or bowel movement.

### Specimen Collection:

- 1. Write the patient's name, date of birth and the sample collection date on the plastic tube containing the paddle.
- 2. Hold the paddle by the cap and remove it from the tube.
- 3. Separate the buttocks and press the tacky side of the paddle firmly against several areas of skin directly around the anal opening.
- 4. Replace the paddle in the tube.
- 5. If return of the specimen is delayed for more than one day, refrigerate the specimen.
- 6. Bring specimen to any Lima Memorial Health System Laboratory site for testing.
